There were heroes and villains who were a part of the events of Jesus' last week. On the Sundays between now and Easter, the pastor will try to help us know more about them. He has talked in recent Sundays about Annas and Caiaphas, two scurrilous rascals who orchestrated Jesus' false trial and crucifixion; a nameless Pitcher Bearer, whose faithfulness allowed Jesus to use him as a point man in planning His Last Supper; and Barabbas, also sur-named Jesus and whose name means "son of a Father." This Sunday, the pastor will speak to us in a first-person dramatic monologue sermon as Simon of Cyrene, forced to carry Jesus' cross. Thomas, the poster child of all who doubt, and Simon Peter, who denied and then proclaimed Jesus, will be also treated. Plan to hear all these sermons.
